

Young Researchers Workshop Tartu – Administrative overview

Workload for students: 156 Academic Hours, 6 ECTS

Application and selection:

Each partner has a budget line to second 1 or 2 people (lecturers and/or young researchers) to the seminar; University of Tartu reserves the right to select participants among all applications received.

Criteria for the selection:

- PhD students or young lecturers in social and political sciences, economics, law and humanities
- Proficiency in English (speaking, reading and writing to understand, express and discuss and put in writing aspects of the field of European Studies)

UniGraz, Yeditepe University, NCFU, Khazar University, Yerevan University have budget to send 2 people to the workshop; Batumi Shota Rustaveli University, New Vision University and Ilia State University have budget to send 1 person to the workshop (please see travel budget).

A motivation letter (2 pages max), which clearly describes applicant's teaching experience, why is he/she teaching, his/her future aspirations related to teaching, and includes a brief description of his/her courses. The motivation letter should be sent to Olena Solohub (Olena.solohub@ut.ee).

Application deadline – **November 15, 2017.**

Notification of all selected participants – 1 week after the application deadline.
