

Ref. New Vision University (NVU) Recruitment Statement

Dear Sir/Madam,

Please be herewith advised about the NVU student recruitment policy. The NVU is a private nonprofit institution aiming at expanding human vision through introducing new approaches in the field of education, research and innovation.

Currently the NVU is at its final stage of preparation for authorization procedures and will be able to offer seven English-language degree programs. The starting date of the educational programs is September 16, 2013. The Recruitment Commission hearings (taking final decision about admission of particular candidates) are scheduled for July 23 and 30, August 13 and 27.

The first phase of the selection procedure is submission of an electronic Letter of Interest to the designated NVU recruitment representative: International Relations Centre (Address: 154 David Aghmashenebeli Avenue, 0102, Tbilisi, Georgia; Tel: +995 32 230 62 34; Email: info@irc.com.ge).

At this stage, the preliminary check of the existence of all relevant preconditions and availability of documents needed for enrollment is being conducted.

The second phase is the filling out and submission of an application form available for downloading from the NVU Web Page from July 1.

The third phase deals with the final proof of meeting the enrollment criteria and mobility-migration issues and is accomplished through issuance of a confirmation of enrollment (granting student status) as well as invitation to enter Georgia.

All the students will be provided with accommodation assistance, curricula tutorial, travel support and health care insurance free of additional charge.

An applicant receives an accommodation assistant who informs him/her about the available placements and provides the detailed information about venue selected according to applicant's desired criteria such as price, location, sharing with other students etc.

Curricula tutor provides all relevant information regarding the program(s), i.e. how to shape one's own profile, available concentrations, major/minor options, necessary prerequisites as well as availability of vacancies for a particular moment.

Travel support is organized to identify the best connection options, including twinning with others (group ticket options) for getting the best price negotiable.

Health care insurance provided by the NVU covers relevant basic medical treatment costs and is handed over to a student after the accomplishment of the enrollment procedures.
